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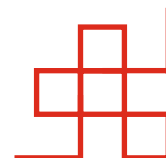
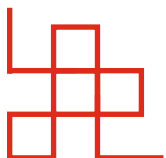
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8 September 2022 -8th Foundation Day

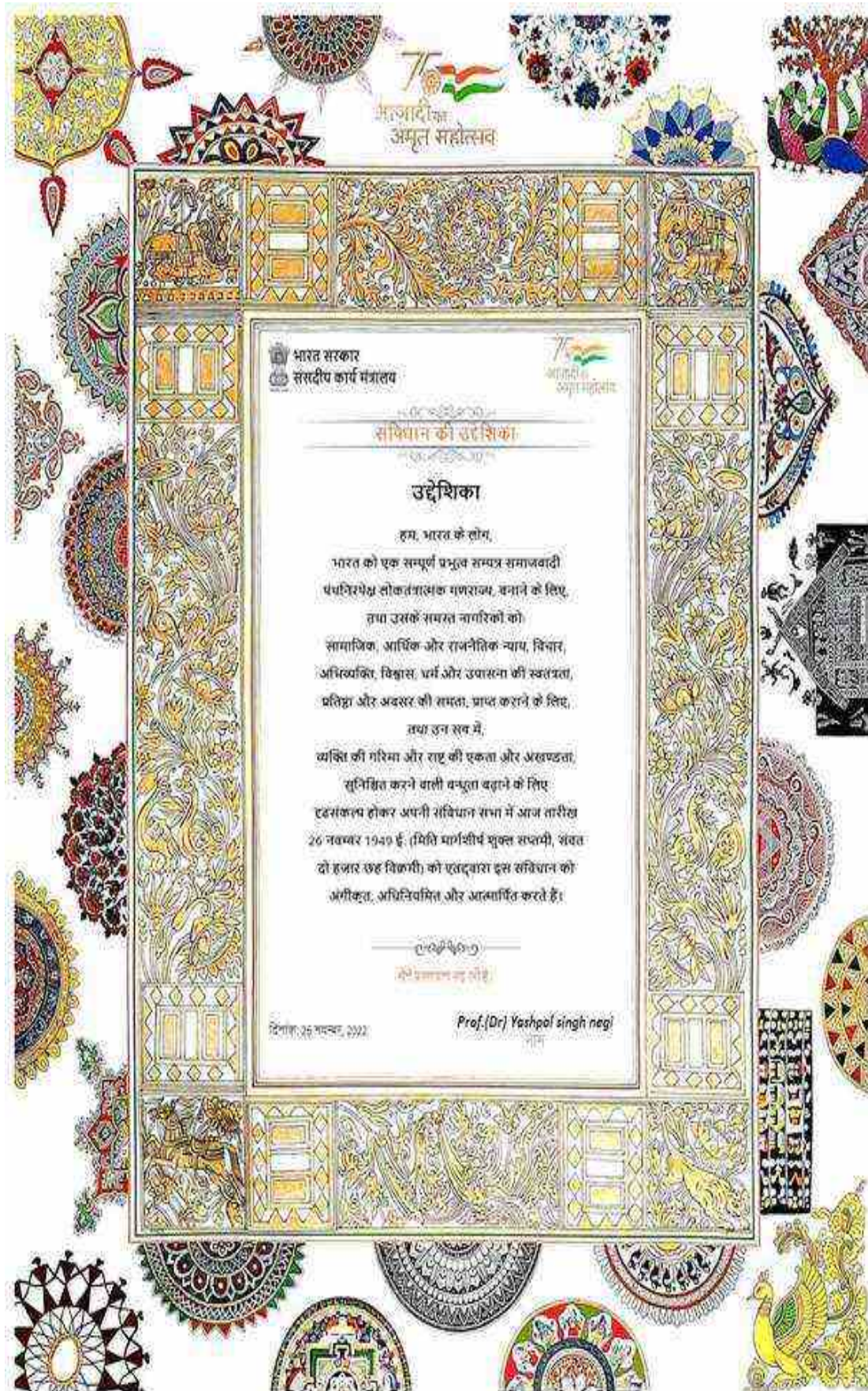

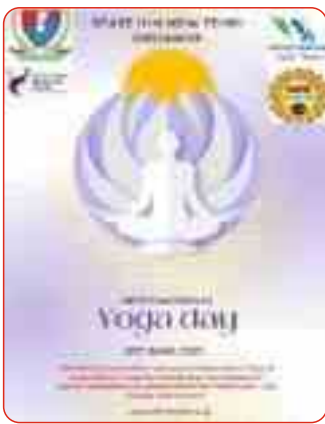

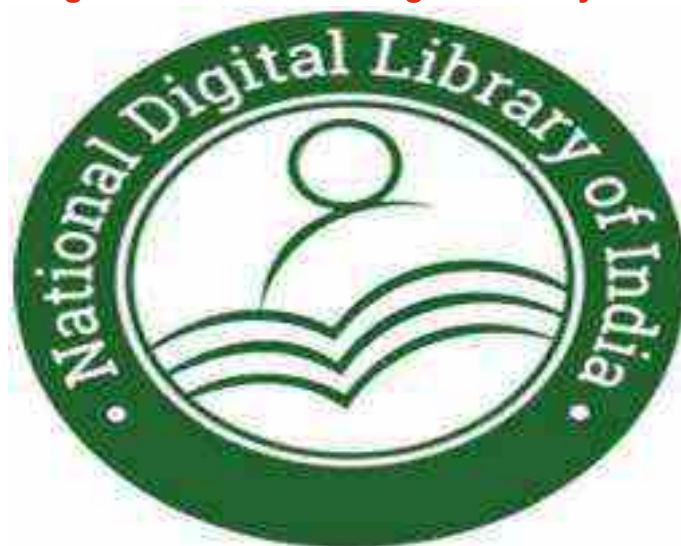
